

- The high strength attachments for all fittings are inserted into the mould, prior to producing the hull.
 - The deck mould is lowered and than clamped onto the hull section.
 - Computer controlled and monitored moulding process.
 - Polyethylene is injected into the mould during the process to create the three layer construction system.
- The dack mould has been removed to reveal the hull shell ready for completion.

 Middle form layer for stiffness
 Inner skin to stabilise the structure
- The strongest attachment for the fittings, provided by brass inserts moulded into the hull structure - adds not only strength, but also accuracy and speed of fit-out.
